Post-Fall Management for Rehabilitation Nurses  
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## Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this course, learners will be able to:

1. Model a simulated post-fall huddle that includes patient presentation on rescue, and assessment of patient status.
2. Sketch the group consensus process for immediate / root cause determination and discussion with the patient.
3. Create recommendations to prevent fall reoccurrence that results in a change in the fall prevention plan of care.
4. Differentiate the post-fall huddle from all other huddles and fall-related processes: pre-shift huddle, post-fall debriefing, and post-fall assessment.
5. Apply the 8 steps of the post fall huddle process to two case studies.
6. Explain the clinical algorithm to guide determination of preventability.
7. Refresh understanding of the role of implementation science when launching or redesigning the post-fall huddle as an intervention.
8. Address formative (structure and process) and summative (outcomes) measures specific to the post-fall huddle.
9. Demonstrate an innovative unit-based storyboard that focuses on clinical practices rather than fall numbers or rate.
